Places to visit in and around Sakleshpur (Malnad Region)



Manjarabad fort is a star fort built in 1792 by Tipu Sultan

Tipu Sultan got this fort built one day by his soldiers when he was establishing his sovereignty over Mysore. Manjarabad fort got its name from the Kannada word 'Manju' which means fog or mist.

Betta Byraveshwara Temple is one of the most ancient temples and is one of the best places to visit in Sakleshpur. The temple is over 6 to 800 years old. It is a small Hindu temple built with black stones in Kadamba style architecture.

Ettina Bhuja is a mountain peak in the Western Ghats, located in Chikmagalur district, Karnataka, about 26 km from Resort . It has a height of 4265 feet. It is a popular and easy trekking point as the last two kilometers can be trekked to reach a point near summit.

The Church was built in 1860 by the French missionaries for the wealthy British estate owners. In 1960 the construction of the Hemavati Dam and Reservoir led to the abandonment of the church. Since then the church submerges in water every year during monsoon season.

Chennakeshava Temple, also referred to as Keshava, Kesava or Vijayanarayana Temple of Belur, is a 12th-century Hindu temple in, Hassan district of Karnataka state, India. It was commissioned by King Vishnuvardhana in 1117 CE, on the banks of the Yagachi River in Belur, an early Hoysala Empire capita.

Distance 40 Kms from Resort

It is the largest monument in Halebidu, a town in the state of Karnataka, India and the former capital of the Hoysala Empire. The temple was built on the banks of a large man-made lake, and sponsored by King Vishnuvardhana of the Hoysala Empire. Its construction started around 1121 CE and was complete in 1160 CE.

At a distance of 39 km from Resort, and 33 km from Hassan, Parvathamma Betta (Shiva Parvathi Temple) is a scenic hill located at Dyathapura village in Karnataka. It is one of the popular places to visit near Hassan, and among the popular places for trekking in Karnataka.

The ghat borders the Bisle Reserve Forest, one of the country's most magnificent rain forests. Its diverse habitat is home to an amazing selection of flora and fauna, making it a must-see for nature lovers. The Bisle Reserve Forest is also a great place for trekking, as well as for bird watching

Yagachi water sports Center, BELUR offers wide varieties of water recreational activities at yagachi back waters, The Yagachi Water Adventure Sports Centre situated 47 kilometres from Resort and 3 kms from Historical place Belur, is a tourist spot set up in backwaters of this dam and offers water sports activities, namely jet ski, speed boat, banana boat, bumper ride, kayaking .

Devaramane Trekking near Mudigere Devaramane trek brings you close to the nature and its an exhilarating experience. A trekker climbs the peaks, walks across the grasslands, crosses gurgling streams, and views magnificent ghats. The area remains green even in summers.



Mallalli Falls is situated in the northern region of Kodagu District, Karnataka. The Kumaradhara River is the main watercourse for this waterfall. The Kumaradhara later flows through Kukke Subrahmanya and merges with the Netravati River at Uppinangadi, which then empties into the Arabian Sea at Mangalore

Mookanamane falls (Abbi falls) near Hetthur Hongadahalla has turned out a big hit among the nature lovers. The falls, which is usually roaring and in full force between June and December, is already overflowing in the first week of this month. The water falls from one to 12 feet height and spread on 50 feet. It mesmerizes those who flock this natural falls.
